## Reconnections:

Compass Insurance Company recommendations: If we reconnect your water supply on, or before, 14th March, we will leave your heating on low to help prevent frost damage. If your reconnection date is after 14th March we will only leave the heating on at your request (Unless it is still frosty at that time). Please give us plenty of notice for your reconnection date (if possible a minimum of 7 days)

When you return to the park for the first time after the closed season, please make your first visit in office hours so we are able to help you should there be any problems.

**NB:** Right now, at the beginning of March the weather is already causing some difficulties with reconnections. The sub-zero temperatures at night, followed by very chilly days, have frozen the water supply to the holiday homes. We have gone as far as we can with each holiday home but until the water supply is ‘back to normal’ please check with the office to confirm the progress before travelling to the park.
